NOTE

REQUIREMENTS

1. All Officers and Instructors are required to complete Darkness to light training 90 days from the day of enrollment. (No Exceptions)
2. All Instructor are required to have completed Officer Midshipman Study Guide (OMSG) 12 months from the day of enrollment. (no exceptions)
3. All Cadets are required to bring to drill a minimum of 4 completed course work.
4. TRAINING – Sea Cadets and League Cadets will review the divisional training plan and discuss the benefits to their personal development and how we can use this tool to enhance training and teamwork.
5. SUMMER TRAINING – Training Schedule and the Foreign Exchange Schedule been released. All cadets who are interested in attending need to have the BMR completed. All cadets going to an advanced training need to submit their request for orders on time.
6. SUPERVISION. Cadets will be supervised at all times. Cadets will not depart the training areas without the permission of the OIC.
7. CONDUCT. Cadets and Service Members will conduct themselves with the highest level of decorum while interacting. The use of foul language, or any other negative conduct, is strictly forbidden. Any cadet / adult who conduct or action is considered contrary to the mission of the NSCC or the Navy should be brought to the immediate attention of the XO or CO. Cadets and Service Members will not exchange phone numbers, friend each other on social media, or have any interaction outside of the work environment. This is for the protection of all parties.
