REQUIREMENTS

- 1. All Officers and Instructors are required to complete Darkness to light training 90 days from the day of enrollment. (No Exceptions)
- 2. All Instructors are expected to have completed Officer Midshipman Study Guide (OMSG) 12 months from the day of enrollment. (No exceptions)
- 3. All Cadets are required to bring to drill a minimum of 4 completed coursework
- 4. TRAINING Sea Cadets and League Cadets will review the divisional training plan and discuss the benefits of their personal development and how we can use this tool to enhance training and teamwork.
- 5. WINTER TRAINING Training Schedule are posted on the training website. All cadets who are interested in attending need to have the BMR completed. All cadets going to advanced training need to submit their request for orders on time.
- 6. SUPERVISION. At all times Cadets will be supervised. Cadets will not depart the training areas without the permission of the OIC.
- 7. CONDUCT. Cadets and Service Members will conduct themselves with the highest level of decorum while interacting. The use of foul language, or any other negative behavior, is strictly forbidden. Any cadet/adult whom conduct or action is considered contrary to the mission of the NSCC the Navy or the District of Columbia Division should be brought up to the immediate attention of the XO or CO.
- 8. Cadets and Service Members will not exchange phone numbers, friend each other on social media, or have any interaction outside of the work environment. It is for the protection of all parties.
